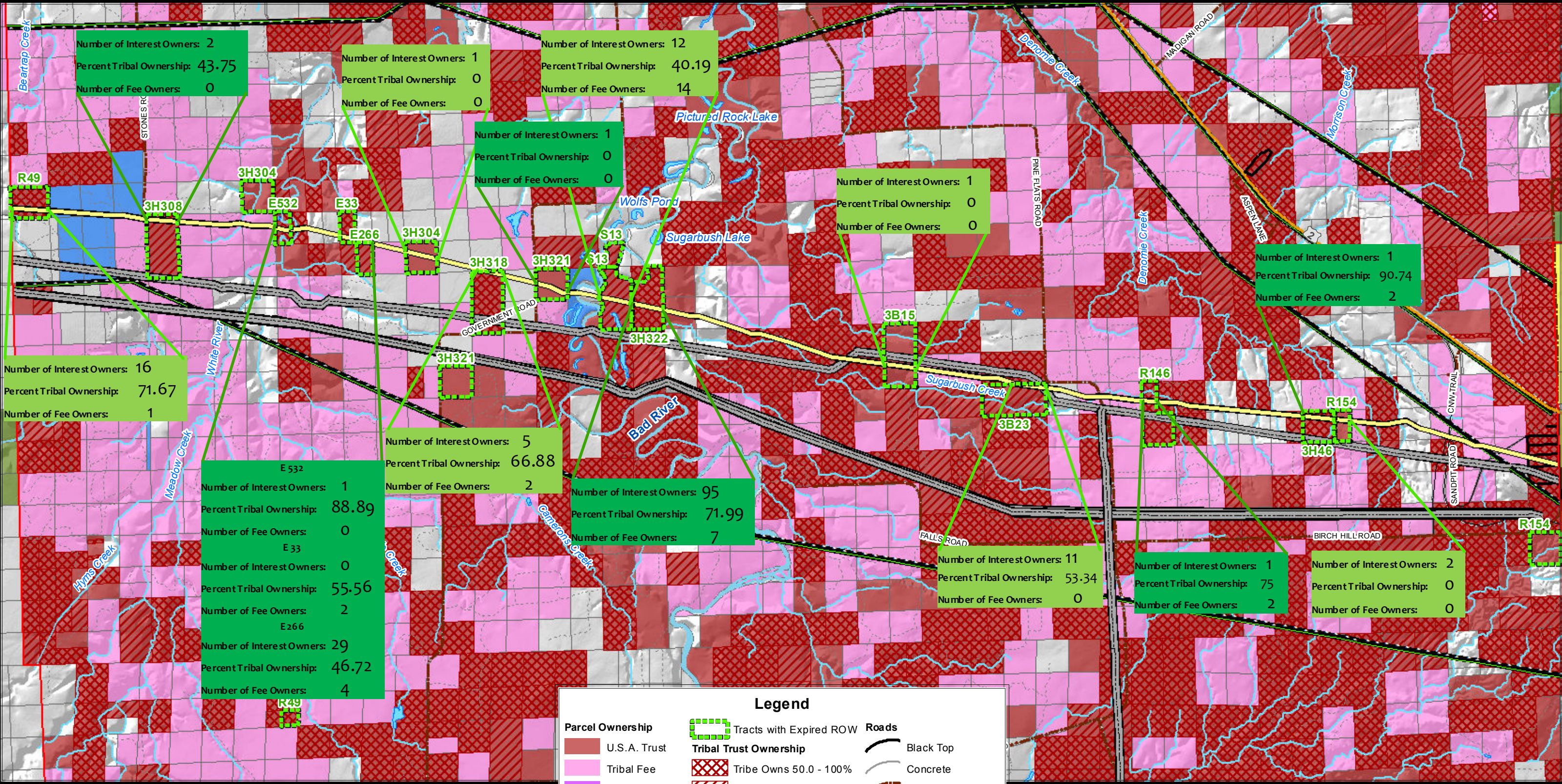


Expired Rights-of-Way Through Tribal and Individual Trust Parcels Along Enbridge Line 5
