What is Community Spread?

Right now, Dane, Kenosha, and Milwaukee counties are seeing “Community Spread” COVID-19. What this means is that people are testing positive who have no exposures to a known case, nor did they travel. This is why it is so important for us to practice social distancing at this time. Keeping our space from others, staying out of crowds, and going out only when necessary are recommended.
