Subject: Bad River Recycling & Solid Waste Department Internal Review Protocol for Prevention of Covid-19

Dee,

The Staff currently takes a number of steps to prevent contracting Covid-19 while working at the Bad River Transfer Station and throughout our scheduled curb-side pick-up routes on a daily which includes the following.

1. Practice Social Distancing (6') of one another when possible and during in-coming customer interactions.
2. PPE that includes latex gloves, surgical masks, safety glasses, Purell hand sanitizer, Lysol wipes and Lysol disinfectant spray, (although we are running low on Purell hand sanitizer and Lysol wipes) like most.
3. The recyclables collected weekly curb-side are placed outside and covered for (1) week and is stored inside the fenced-in household hazardous waste area which is on-site.
4. Complete Staff Covid-19 testing as a group at the Bad River Clinic tentatively scheduled next week.
5. All Staff is encouraged to stay home if not feeling well, (although a way to test for fevers before entrance could definitely be beneficial).

I have encouraged the Staff that we should continue to use masks outside our work environment also but I believe if it came from our employer it would carry more weight, especially on-site.

Dee,

This is the addendum added to preventive steps taken in case an employee at the Bad River Transfer Station feels sick and believes it may be Covid-19 related.

6. I would have employee(s) contact Bad River Health & Wellness Center to schedule a Covid-19 test (a.s.a.p.) and I would confirm by phone call that indeed he did get tested and is self-quarantined at home until test results are back. If a Staff member test comes back positive then I would have the reminding Staff tested and placed on self-quarantine up to (10-14) days.

This would basically shut down our ability to perform our operation for that time frame essentially.
