COVID-19 NEWS

- If you are sick: PLEASE CALL FIRST to schedule an appointment or to obtain home testing kits.
- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends testing for COVID-19:
 - ✓ If you have COVID-19 symptoms
 - ✓ If you have known or suspected close contact with someone who has COVID-19
 - ✓ Before or after travel
- COVID-19 home tests are available, please call the clinic @ 715-682-7133.
- Recipients of Moderna or Pfizer as their primary series (1st and 2nd shots) must wait 5 months after the first shot (primary series) to get the booster.
- Covid vaccine clinics will continue throughout March. The Covid-19 vaccines for 6 months through 4 years have been delayed. We will provide an update when available.
