## **COVID-19 NEWS**

- **Kids ages 5-11 years can now receive their BOOSTER DOSE at least 5 months after 2<sup>nd</sup> primary dose OR at least 3 months after 3<sup>rd</sup> primary dose of Pfizer for moderately or severely immunocompromised.**
- **Covid vaccines will be available at the end of June for the 6 months to 4-year-old children. Clinics for this age group will be by appointment only. Date TBD.**
- **If you are sick: PLEASE CALL FIRST to schedule an appointment or to obtain home testing kits.**
- **The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends testing for COVID-19:**
  - ✓ If you have COVID-19 symptoms
  - ✓ If you have known or suspected close contact with someone who has COVID-19
  - ✓ Before or after travel
- **COVID-19 home tests are available, please call the clinic @ 715-682-7133.**
- **Covid vaccine clinics will continue through summer 2022.**
