**AHT:** The Wisconsin Legislature's 2006 Prevent Violence Against Children Act went into effect in April 2007. The Act required that all child care providers working with children under age 5 years receive training in Shaken Baby Syndrome (SBS) Prevention and how to manage crying, fussing, or distraught children. Wisconsin's required SBS Training for Child Care Providers has been updated and renamed Abusive Head Trauma (AHT) Prevention Training for Child Care Providers. Shaken Baby Syndrome is one form of Abusive Head Trauma. The training will address the latest information on: ▪ Abusive Head Trauma ▪ The Period of Purple Crying ▪ Strategies and challenges of soothing ▪ Coping with frustration ▪ Having a plan and educating others.

**SIDS:** This training is designed to help child care providers and parents have a better understanding of the risk factors identified in cases of SIDS deaths and the techniques that have been identified as reducing the instances of SUIDS (Sudden Unexplained Infant Deaths). Practices for responding to a non-breathing infant will be examined.
