COVID-19 NEWS

- OCTOBER 2022: BRHWC Influenza Clinics will have the COVID-19 vaccines available (all-series COVID vaccines including the new Pfizer Bivalent COVID booster dose). The Pfizer Bivalent (Original and OMICRON BA.4/BA.5) is to prevent COVID-19 in individuals 12 years of age and older who have completed their primary COVID vaccinations. More information and dates to follow soon.
- Covid numbers each week are the total number of in-house and community athome positive Covid cases reported to the clinic. Please make sure if you test positive that you are calling the clinic Monday through Friday from 8-4:30 pm to report.
- PFIZER vaccine is available for the 6 months to 4-year-old children. The next clinics for this age group is September 14th & 28th from 10 AM until NOON with a 30-minute observation time. <u>Clinics for this age group will be by appointment only.</u>
- If you are sick: PLEASE CALL FIRST to schedule an appointment or to obtain home testing kits. If it is after clinic hours, please call or go to Memorial Medical Center if needed.
- > The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends testing for COVID-19:
 - ✓ If you have COVID-19 symptoms
 - ✓ If you have known or suspected close contact with someone who has COVID-19
 - ✓ Before or after travel
- COVID-19 home tests are available, please call the clinic @ 715-682-7133.
- > Covid vaccine clinics will continue throughout fall 2022.
