- **No alcohol, drugs or behavioral-altering substances allowed. If a Child is required to take medications during the event, please notify your chaperone.**
- **Stockbridge Munsee and Great Lakes Inter Tribal Employees**
- **Cell phones will be given to chaperones and used only upon permission and in areas that are allowed during the event.**
- **BE RESPECTFUL of all Elders, fellow participants, and other contributing participants in the event.**
- **Showers will be available on site, please bring bedding needed for sleep as well as amenities for hygiene activities (shower, brushing teeth, change of clothes, etc.)**
- **Meals and snacks will be provided. Please inform us and your chaperone of any special dietary needs.**
- **A sacred fire will be lit prior to event and tended to throughout the ceremony**
- **Please think of questions or discussion points you would like to speak to Elders about.**
- **There will be safe, supportive, and quiet place available to process if needed.**
- **Special entertainment event for all youth.**
- **All activities are free of charge.**
- **Criminal background screenings have been conducted on all chaperones and volunteers.**
- **This is a Native operated and run event. We are so happy for your participation!**
