BAD RIVER RECYCLING & SOLID WASTE REQUIREMENTS / GUIDELINE

PREPARATION OF RECYCLABLES, PLEASE SEPARATE

PAPER PRODUCTS

1. NEWSPAPER; Must be tied, bagged, or bundled for safe transportation.

EXAMPLES OF PAPER GARBAGE; Toilet paper, Napkins, Paper Towels,
Tissue, Christmas wrapping paper, Candy wrappers & Dog / Cat /
Potato chip bags.

2. BROWN BAGS; Tied or bagged separately, can be used to separate recycling.
3. MAGAZINES; Must be tied, bagged or bundled.
4. CORRUGATED CARDBOARD; Must be flattened, bundled, tied, taped or boxed.
5. WAX CARDBOARD; (6, 12, 24, 30 pk boxes); Must be flattened, bundled, tied, taped, bagged or boxed.
6. OFFICE PAPER; Must be bagged or bundled for safe transportation.
(Please bag shredded paper also).

CONTAINERS – All containers must be rinsed clean, emptied with lids & caps removed.

- 1. ALUMINUM;** Place in recycling bin, or in plastic or paper bags.
- 2. TIN CANS;** Place in recycling bin, or in plastic or paper bags.
- 3. GLASS;** Only Blue, Brown, White, Clear & Green containers acceptable. (Ceramics are considered garbage)
- 4. PLASTICS:** Only #1's (Soda, Water Bottles, Plastic Peanut Butter Jars, Cooking Oil Containers, etc., anything with #1 inside the triangle on bottom of containers) are acceptable.

Only #2's (Milk Jugs, Shampoo, Detergent Bottles, Cleaning Products, etc., anything with #2 inside the triangle on bottom of containers) are acceptable.

Numbers 3, 4, 5, etc. (Anything with these #'s inside the triangle on bottom of containers) are considered garbage by WDNR.

EXAMPLES OF OTHER GARBAGE; Tin/Aluminum Foil, Styrofoam, Air Filters, Surgical Masks, Diapers, Tampons, Old Clothing & Any Used Fireworks.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE – Minimum disposal fees required on some items, when the following items are brought to the Recycling Center.

- 1. USED MOTOR OIL:** Must be placed in a sealed container to prevent spillage, @ no cost. (Detergent bottles & milk jugs are good to use, tape cap so container is sealed).
- 2. MOTOR OIL FILTERS:** Requires sealed container to prevent spillage, @ no cost.
- 3. TRANSMISSION FLUIDS:** NWRPC pricing currently @ .50c/lb. & must be in sealed container.
- 4. ANTI – FREEZE:** Same as above
- 5. GAS:** (old, bad); Same as above.
- 6. SHARPS –** Must be in sealed container; (detergent container with taped, capped lid) are acceptable.

HARD TO RECYCLE WASTE – Minimum disposal fee required when some of the following items are brought to the Recycling Center.

- 1. WHITE GOODS: Refrigerators/Freezers/Air Conditioners require disposal fees, depending on size, to help off-set cost to extract freon. (Most Washers, Dryers, Stoves, Hot Water Heaters have no disposal fees.)**
- 2. ELECTRONIC WASTE: Televisions, Microwaves, Computer Components, etc., have required disposal fees, depending on size of items. (Current Pricing list available on-site).**
- 3. OTHER WASTE: TIRES (\$3 per car/sm. truck tire), Batteries – (Nicads, Lithium, Mercury) are currently priced @ \$2.50/lb. for disposal fee. Most alkaline batteries (AAA, AA & A) nowadays are ecofriendly & contain little or no mercury. As a result, they're considered nontoxic enough to toss out with the household trash according to the WDNR, with Congress passing the Mercury-Containing Battery Management Act in 1996. Emptied burn barrels and automotive batteries are recyclable, @ no cost.**

The Bad River Recycling & Solid Waste Department provides dumpster rentals to the community with an "On-Site Waste Disposal Dumpster Roll-Off Container Service Agreement Form". Rental Agreement Forms can be picked up @ the Recycling Center. Current dumpster sizes are 8, 10, 12, 15 yards with some having top locking lids for containment. An Up-Front Deposit covers Set-up & Rental cost, with Final Payment for weight total still due, once it is picked up @ .10c/lb. Copies of all supporting documents included with Final Payment. (Elderly/Disabled Rates are @ .07c/lb. including 25% off set-up & rental cost).

BAD RIVER RECYCLING, SOLID WASTE AND CURBSIDE PICK-UP SCHEDULE

(PLEASE REMEMBER TO PUT ITEMS OUT BY 8:00 A.M.)

One 33 – gallon garbage bag requires (1) Blue Residential Sticker / garbage bags over 33 – gallon MUST have (2) Blue Residential Stickers, or an Orange Sticker will be placed on garbage bag explaining why it did NOT get picked up.

Two 13 – gallon garbage bags require (1) Blue Residential Sticker. Please do NOT tear sticker in half for (1) 13 – gallon garbage bag, it will void sticker and pick up.
