APPLY FOR ENERGY ASSISTANCE

Beginning October 1, individuals can apply for the Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP). This program assists eligible families with a one-time benefit payment for the heating season. The amount of assistance benefit depends on the household size, income level, and household heating costs. You may also qualify for crisis assistance and the furnace repair/replacement program.

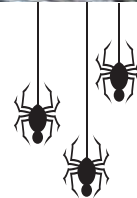
