Access Permits in Emergency Situations

In emergency situations, an entity should immediately communicate to MNRD initial information about any needed access; however, the entity should concurrently proceed with access to address the emergency situation and not wait for MNRD to process and issue an access permit. MNRD will issue an after-the-fact access permit in emergency situations. An entity can update its access permit request as needed after the emergency response is implemented and at a point when it is safe to do so. The *Standard Conditions on Access* (as described in the Band's access permit template available at https://www.badriver-nsn.gov/wp-content/uploads/2022/08/AccessPermit_BadRiver_Fillable_TemplateForm_2021.pdf) apply in emergency situations to the extent practicable and safe to implement, with the exception that the equipment inspection requirement will be waived by MNRD. Access permit fees apply (fee structure available at http://www.badriver-nsn.gov/wp-content/uploads/2020/02/NRD_AccessPermitFeeStructure.pdf), and MNRD will send an entity

an after-the-fact invoice.
