Bad River Manoomin Celebration Vendor Application

To ensure that the 2026 Manoomin Celebration is conducted in a safe and respectful manner, the Bad River Powwow Committee will implement and enforce the following restrictions.

1. All Arts and Craft Vendors must offer authentic, handmade crafts-mass-produced items and toys are not permitted.
2. The use or possession of drugs and alcohol is strictly prohibited on the powwow grounds. If found in violation Law Enforcement will be found.
3. All Vendors are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and appropriate manner.
4. All VENDORS are REQUIRED to keep their stand and the surrounding area neat and clean (Before & After).
5. All VENDORS are REQUIRED to have their stand ready for business by 3 PM on Friday, August 14, 2026.
6. All food vendors **must always** have someone in their booth who holds a **current Food Safety Handler Certificate**. <https://www.ihs.gov/foodhandler/>
7. The holder of the Tribal ID must be present at the stand throughout the duration of the pow-wow.
