REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The Bad River Band of Lake Superior of Chippewa Indians is seeking proposals for Mural Installation at Bad River Health and Wellness Center

The Bad River Health and Wellness Center is seeking proposals for an Ojibwe floral border to be installed along the middle of a wall, approximately 100 feet long and 2 to 3 feet wide.

Scope of Work

- Design original murals that reflect the themes of Ojibwe floral
- Prepare and install murals on the specified wall sections.
- Use durable, easy-to-clean materials suitable for high-traffic areas.
- Coordinate installation with center staff to minimize disruption.
- Areas will be kept clean and always organized and clean up.

Bid Description

Bidders must submit a complete proposal for the design, preparation, and installation of an Ojibwe floral border mural at the Bad River Health and Wellness Center. The bid should clearly describe the proposed design approach, materials, installation method, project schedule, and total cost. Proposals should also demonstrate relevant experience, ability to complete the work in a professional manner, and compliance with all project requirements stated in this request for proposals.

Proposal Requirements

1. Artist statement, portfolio highlighting relevant experience with at least one professional reference letter.

2. Detailed project timeline, including design, preparation, and installation phases.
3. Budget estimate covering materials, labor, and any additional costs.

The Bad River Band of Lake Superior Tribe of Chippewa Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized under Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, U.S.C. Section 476. This entitles the Tribe to government pricing and exempts the Tribe from state sales and use taxes and from federal excise taxes. Therefore, price quotations should not include such taxes.

This Request for Proposals is open to all qualified, responsive bidders. Indian Preference will apply in the selection process in accordance with the Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance (TERO) or the Indian Preference Act of 1934 (Title 25, USC, Section 47), based on funding source requirements. Questions regarding TERO, and if the TERO fee applies to the RFP, may be directed to the Bad River Band's Human Resource office at 715-682-7111.

Firms or persons applying for Indian preference must provide evidence in its proposal of 51% or more Indian ownership. In addition, the firm or person must provide evidence of structure, management and financing affecting the Indian character of the firm. Documentation of and compliance with Indian Preference must accompany the proposal. Sealed bids must be labeled BRHWC Mural & submitted by June 30, 2026, at 4:30 pm.
