REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR ROADSIDE GARBAGE CLEANUP

Bad River Band of Lake Superior Tribe of Chippewa Indians, Roads Dept is seeking proposals for the cleanup of dumped materials at a site along Birch Hill Rd. Tribal Member strongly preferred as the site is on the Reservation and non-members will require an access permit to even get to the waste materials.

Location is approximately 1.25 miles south on Birch Hill Rd from the intersection with US Hwy 2. Coordinates are 46° 30' 41.22"N 90° 33' 32.73"W

Location is identified on the attached images; images also show an example of some of the waste materials that need to be removed. Waste materials are on both sides of the roadway. **ALL PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS PLEASE NOTE, LOCATIONS ARE FAR DOWN A STEEP SLOPE.** This will mean removal of the waste materials will be a challenge.

Proposal will need to include:

- Lump sum cost to remove the materials, transport of and disposal of the materials at a proper disposal center
- Bidder is responsible for coordinating proper disposal and payment of disposing of the materials at a proper disposal center
- Bidder is responsible for transportation of and the cost of transportation of the materials to the proper disposal center
- Bidder will be responsible for providing before and after photos of the areas

The Bad River Band of Lake Superior Tribe of Chippewa Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized under Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, U.S.C. Section 476. This entitles the Tribe to government pricing and exempts the Tribe from state sales and use taxes and from federal excise taxes. Therefore, price quotations should not include such taxes.

This Request for Proposals is open to all qualified, responsive bidders. Indian Preference will apply in the selection process in accordance with the Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance (TERO) or the Indian Preference Act of 1934 (Title 25, USC, Section 47), based on funding source requirements. Questions regarding TERO, and if the TERO fee applies to the RFP, may be directed to the Bad River Band's Human Resource office at 715-682-7111.

Firms or persons applying for Indian preference must provide evidence in its proposal of 51% or more Indian ownership. In addition, the firm or person must provide evidence of structure, management and financing affecting the Indian character of the firm. Documentation of and compliance with Indian Preference must accompany the proposal.

Sealed bids must be labeled **BIRCH HILL ROAD SITE CLEANUP** and submitted by Thursday September 17, 2026 at 4:30pm to:

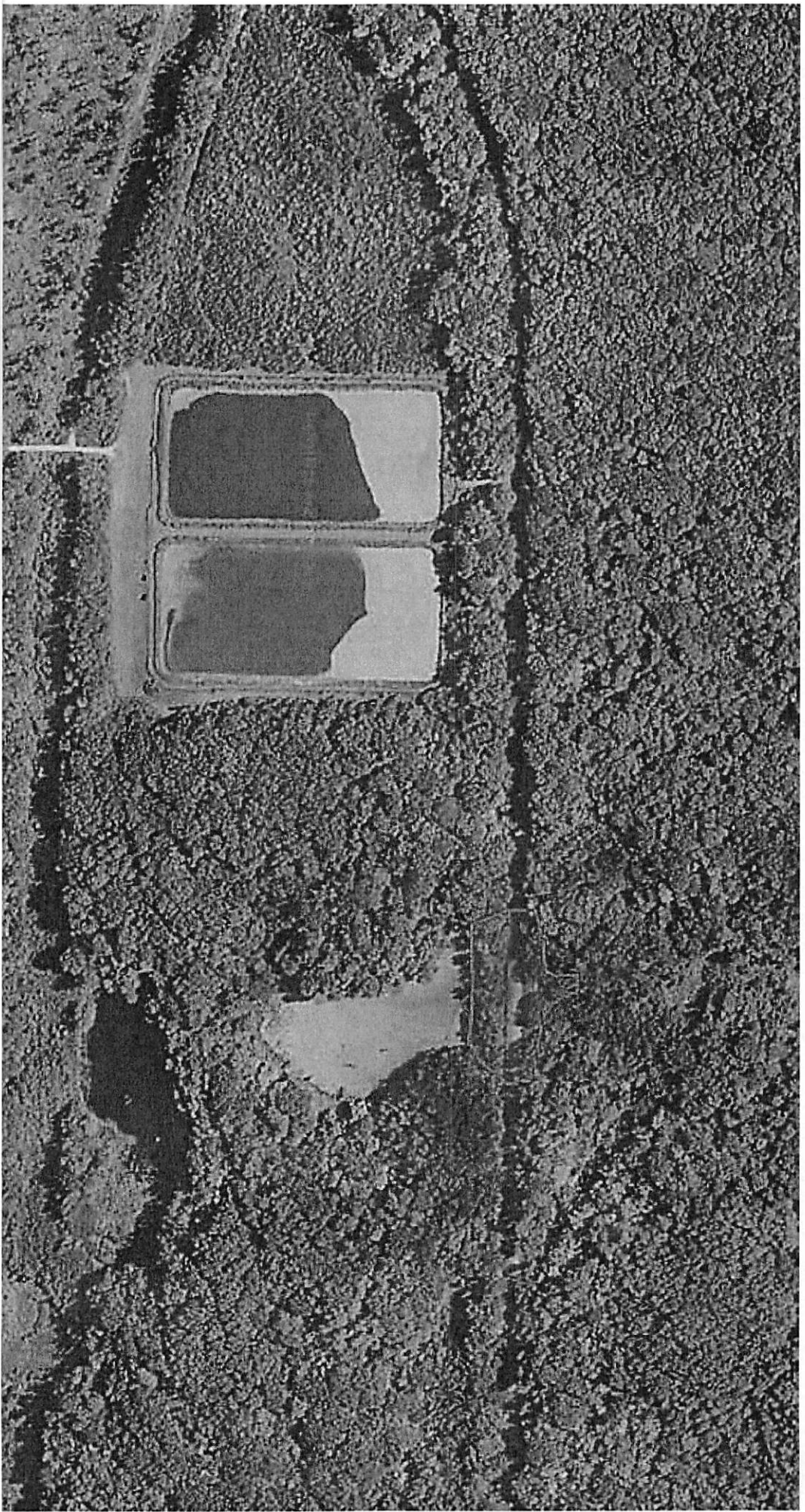
