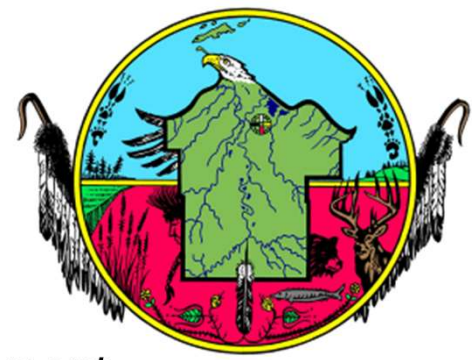

# **WEEKLY UPDATE OF LOG JACK PROJECT AT BAD RIVER**

## **CURRENT PROJECT STATUS**

- Demobilization and initial restoration began on March 6, 2025, and is now on hold until seasonal road restrictions are lifted. Enbridge crew demobilized from the site on March 19, 2025.
- The Permittee (Enbridge) and MNRD will be monitoring the log jack structure regularly throughout 2025 and 2026 to evaluate performance and identify any needed corrective measures to protect the environment.

## **PROJECT WORK COMPLETED WEEK ENDING MAR 22, 2025**

- Water quality monitoring stations up- and downstream of project site were partially removed. Remaining equipment will be removed once river levels decrease in the coming weeks.
- All matting was removed from the access trail east of Government Road. A portion of the matting in the staging area west of Government Road has been removed and stacked on-site.
- Construction equipment has been removed, and the entry and exit points into the staging area have been blocked with spare log jacks. The entry to the access trail have been blocked by boulders to prevent vehicle traffic and minimize impacts to wetlands and natural resources.
- The Permittee has demobilized from the site until seasonal road restrictions are lifted.

## **PROJECT SCHEDULE WEEK OF MAR 24, 2025**

- The Permittee will continue to monitor conditions and will coordinate removal of remaining water quality monitoring equipment as conditions allow. The Permittee will complete a site inspection.
- The Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) will visit the site with MNRD and Enbridge to observe the log jack installation.

## **NOTICES TO BAD RIVER BAND TRIBAL MEMBERS**

- Birch products from the Project site are available for tribal member use at the community center.
- Use caution if traveling on the Bad River both upstream and downstream. There are signs signaling the presence of woody debris in the river.
